The Lynxx is a 4 metre sit-on-top that will stack on top of another Lynxx, the Cuttlefish or the Pelagic. It can be safely and easily used by 1 or 2 adults, or a couple of adults and children (up to the total weight capacity).

Front and rear seats mean two adults can use it as a double, whilst the centre seat allows a child passenger to come along for the ride. The centre seat is positioned for balanced paddling by an adult on their own and all 3 positions have foot wells to brace against when paddling for maximum power.

Suitable for use on flat water, the Lynxx can be taken into small surf. "Kiss-offs" moulded into the hull provide structural support, as well as allowing water to drain through quickly should a wave come over the top.

The concave-shaped bow creates lift over waves, chop and swell, whilst the integrated keel helps to keep the Lynxx on a straight course and gives extra control when riding down waves.

Super strong stainless steel bars are moulded into the hull and allow an optional backrest to be quickly and easily attached for each of the 3 seating positions. There is storage space within the hull that is accessible through a large rubber "push-on" hatch and is included as a standard feature (not an optional upgrade).

If you are looking for a sit-on-top kayak that is balanced enough to be used as a single or double, then the Lynxx is the kayak for you.

11 features that make the Lynxx a great choice for your family

- 1 The hull is wide and extremely stable. Moulded-in ridges on the under side of the hull give structural support, whilst an integrated keel keeps the Lynxx on a straight course effortlessly.
- 2 The inclusion of front-to-rear "rocker", along with soft chines on the bow and hard chines on the rear means the Lynxx is very responsive when quick turning is required.
- 3 The tapered bow makes it easy to get the Lynxx up & moving, and gives superior lift over waves, chop & swell. The unique shape of the bow deflects water away from the midline keeping the paddlers dry.
- 4 "Kiss-offs" are positioned in the seat and foot wells for maximum drainage. They form pillars between the top and bottom of the hull that maintain the structural integrity of the Lynxx.
- 5 There are front and rear seats for 2 person paddling, as well as a centre seat position for a child passenger, or for balanced single adult paddling.
- 6 The Lynxx maintains floatation with the Australis standard "air lock" buoyancy, as well as foam included internally.
- 7 There are foot wells for all three paddling positions and they are positioned slightly lower than the seat, minimising fatigue and cramping. This feature prevents pressure building up in the muscles of the legs and lower back, and keeps your paddling position relaxed and comfortable.

Please note:

If your feet are at the same height or slightly higher than your seat, Hamstrings and lower back muscles are on full stretch for extended periods of time. This can result in injury because of a reduced range of motion to absorb the dynamics of paddling, or muscle cramps and tingling due to reduced blood flow to the area or localised pressure on nervous tissues.

- 8 The backrests attach to stainless steel bars moulded into the hull (not riveted or screwed on) giving the most secure backrest attachment.
- 9 A large oval hatch located at the centre of the Lynxx accesses the internal storage area. Optional storage pods can be added for the front and rear paddlers.
- 10 Moulded hand toggles at each end of the Lynxx make two person carrying comfortable and easy. The inclusion of moulded hand-holds at the centre of balance make it easy to carry the Lynxx by yourself.
- 11 The top deck profile allows the Lynxx to stack for fuss free storage & transporting. The Lynxx will stack on top of another Lynxx, the Cuttlefish or the Pelagic.
