The Squid is a robust sit-on-top that can be used by children as young as 8 years of age & will take large adults, up to 130 kilograms.

Soft chines on the bow, hard chines on the rear and the inclusion of front-to-back "rocker" means the Squid turns fast and manoeuvres better than any other 3 metre sit-on in the market.

The tapered bow of the Squid will lift over rather than push through water and maintains effortless gliding when you stop paddling. A moulded-in keel keeps the Squid on a straight course and the wide hull gives superb stability - Some people even sit "side saddle" dangling their legs over the edge when fishing.

"Kiss-offs" in the hull provide structural support and allow water to drain through quickly. 6mm decklines down each side of the Squid give numerous points to grab onto from the water.

The storage area within the hull is accessed through two push-on hatches on the deck. These ports are so large that you can even put a 6 foot fishing rod in through the rear hatch!

Take the Squid for a paddle for yourself and see why we can say "the Squid is the best performing 3 metre sit-on available in Australia"!

11 reasons the Squid is the best performing 3 metre sit-on available in Australia

- 1 The hull is wide, flat and extremely stable. Moulded-in ridgeson the under-side of the hull give structural support, whilst an integrated keel keeps the Squid on a straight line effortlessly. The inclusion of "rocker" combined with soft chines on the bow and hard chines on the rear means the Squid is very responsive when quick turning is required.
- 2 The tapered bow makes it easy to get the Squid up & moving, and gives superior lift over waves, chop & swell. The unique shape of the bow deflects water away from the midline keeping the paddler dry.
- 3 "Kiss-offs" are positioned in the seat and foot-wells for maximum drainage. They form pillars between the top and bottom of the hull that maintain the structural integrity of the Squid.
- 4 The seat is extra wide & extremely comfortable for larger people. The depth of the seat well provides exceptional lower back support.
- 5 The backrest attaches to stainless steel bars moulded into the hull (not riveted or screwed on) giving the most secure backrest attachment.
- 6 6mm decklines along both sides of the Squid give multiple secure places to grab onto from the water. The supports that the decklines run through are super strong & will not pull off, as they are moulded in as part of the hull (not riveted or screwed on).
 - Double Floatation! The air lock of the hull is the primary floatation. In addition, closed cell foam is enclosed within the hull giving a secondary source of floatation and providing supplementary structural support.





8 The foot well positioned slightly lower than the seat gives the optimal biomechanical paddling position that minimises fatigue & cramping. This prevents pressure building up in the muscles of the legs & lower back, and keeps your paddling position relaxed & comfortable. Please note:

If your feet are at the same height or slightly higher than your seat, Hamstrings and lower back muscles are on full stretch for extended periods of time. This can result in injury because of a reduced range of motion to absorb the dynamics of paddling, or muscle cramps and tingling due to reduced blood flow to the area or localised pressure on nervous tissues.

- 9 The push-on hatches are easy to remove & replace without having to fuss with clips & buckles, and provide access to the storage space within the hull. The Squid has the most extensive access to the storage space in its class!
- 10 A drink bottle recess in moulded into each Squid and is conveniently positioned within arm's reach.
- 1 Moulded hand toggles located at each end of the Squid make two person carrying comfortable & easy. The inclusion of moulded hand-holds at the centre of balance make it easy to carry the Squid by yourself.
